

RECYCLING INFORMATION FOR **ASU, TOWN OF BOONE, AND WATAUGA COUNTY**

ASU RECYCLING SITES- ITEMS ACCEPTED- ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDINGS



MIXED PAPER (including PASTEBOARD): Office paper, newspaper, magazines, glossy, junk mail, and pasteboard such as cereal and dry food boxes, paper towel and toilet paper rolls, shoe boxes, and brown paper bags.

TELEPHONE BOOKS: Box or bag and place next to existing recycling site.

BOOKS: Picked up upon request- please box and label for recycling.

CARDBOARD: corrugated cardboard- PLEASE FLATTEN BOXES!

BOTTLES AND CANS (PLASTIC BOTTLES, ALUMINUM CANS AND STEEL CANS): Please rinse before recycling. Plastics (#1 through #7)- Bottles Only (neck must be smaller than base).

GLASS (ALL COLORS): Please keep in separate container and place next to existing recycling site!

ASU- SPECIAL RECYCLING- ITEMS ACCEPTED

Drop off at special recycling locations in Student Union and Technology Support Services

PRINTER CARTRIDGES: place in original package when possible

CELL PHONES including accessories

BATTERIES

COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, CDs, DVDs, DISKETTES, FILM, ETC

PLASTIC BAGS: accepted at Student Union site only!

COMPACT FLUORESCENT BULBS (CFLs): accepted at Student Union Info Desk only!

CONFIDENTIAL RECYCLING: accepted at Post Office in confidential recycling slot

RIGID PLASTICS: accepted at Student Union site only--bulky plastic items such as plastic toys, plastic buckets, plastic laundry baskets, microwave trays, yogurt containers, plastic totes, plastic coolers, plastic shelving, plastic dish drainers, plastic flower pots, plastic waste baskets, five gallon water bottles. Please empty and wash out. Do not include plastic bottles, plastic bags, or medical waste. If your item is too large to fit in the bin, please deliver it to the information desk near Cascades. REMEMBER...Reduce, Reuse and THEN Recycle!

WASTE REDUCTION TIPS

REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF PACKAGING YOU BUY, REUSE WHEN YOU CAN, AND RECYCLE OR COMPOST THE REST

DOUBLE-SIDE COPY AND USE OLD SHEETS AS SCRATCH PAPER FOR NOTES

MINIMIZE PAPER USE BY DISTRIBUTING INFORMATION ELECTRONICALLY

BUY RECYCLED CONTENT PRODUCTS

REUSE NOTEBOOKS, FOLDERS, AND HANGING FILES, AMONG OTHER ITEMS

USE A REUSABLE COFFEE MUG OR CUP INSTEAD OF DISPOSABLES & PACK LUNCHES IN REUSABLE CONTAINERS

SHOP WITH REUSABLE SHOPPING BAGS

DONATE UNWANTED ITEMS TO A LOCAL THRIFT OR CHARITY

RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM



GLASS: Recycle all glass food jars & beverage bottles (all colors).

DO NOT put in bin: light bulbs, cookware, mirrors, window (plate) glass, dishes, drinking glasses, medicine bottles or broken glass. Remove all lids & caps and rinse out containers.

ALUMINUM/STEEL CANS: Recycle all food & beverage cans.

DO NOT put in bin: aluminum foil, aluminum pie plates, etc.

PAPER: Recycle all newspapers, magazines, catalogs, school paper, junk mail & phone books.

PASTEBOARD: Cereal, dry food, and shoe boxes; toilet paper rolls and paper towel rolls;

brown paper bags. No wax coated pasteboard such as juice or milk cartons, PIZZA BOXES or frozen food boxes.

If refrigeration or freezer is required, it CAN NOT be recycled. Please remember to flatten all pasteboard.

DO NOT put in bin: Corrugated cardboard boxes, PIZZA BOXES or any other type of paper.

PLASTIC: Recycle all plastic bottles & all plastics with #1 & #2 recycle symbol on bottom.

DO NOT put in bin: any plastic other than the above. Plastic caps can be placed on after crushing.

Weekly curbside recycling is available to all single residential dwellings up to a tri-plex. Bins are provided.

For residents of apartment/condos with 4 or more units, contact landlord/property owner for recycling detail.

TOWN OF BOONE'S RECYCLING CENTER

Boone has placed a recycling center in the Horn in the West lower parking lot on Horn in the West Dr. This center is un-manned and is open daily. Recyclable items accepted at this site are all curbside recyclables listed above as well as corrugated cardboard (OCC). **Please note that this is strictly a recycling center. Garbage should be disposed of at curbside according to Town Ordinance or taken to Watauga Co. Landfill.**

TOWN OF BOONE'S PUBLIC WORKS CENTER

321 East King St. (Hours: 7:30am-5:00pm) is a DROP-SITE for:

CATALOGS,PHONEBOOKS, NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES : Place under awning at side of building.

BATTERIES: Only dry cell household batteries. They can be rechargeable or one-time use. Drop-site is inside.

COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS: Place light in a sealed zip-lock type bag before bringing to drop-site inside.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Flatten & put in the cardboard container inside gate in back of lot to left of building.

WATAUGA COUNTY

Convenience Center Recycling Program

For site locations, go to www.wataugacounty.org and click on "recycling"

GLASS: Clear, brown and green glass containers. Please rinse and separate by color.

PLASTIC: Includes all plastic bottles and ALL plastics #1 and #2. Check bottom of container for number. All colors accepted.

CARDBOARD: Corrugated cardboard **ONLY**. Please break boxes down flat

PAPER AND PASTEBOARD: Newspaper and inserts; magazines; office paper; junk mail; cereal, soda, beer, dry food and shoe boxes; toilet paper and paper towel rolls and paper bags. No wax coated pasteboard such as juice and milk containers.

BATTERIES: Only dry cell household batteries. They can be rechargeable or one-time use.

METAL: Tin cans, aluminum cans, foil and all metal jar and bottle lids. Empty and rinse all containers. NO paint, pesticide or aerosol cans, metal strapping or propane cylinders.

COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS (CFLs): Only compact fluorescent lights are accepted. Place light in zip-lock bag and give to site attendant. Tube-like bulbs are not accepted.

Items Accepted for Recycling at Watauga County Transfer Station

RIGID PLASTICS toys, buckets, crates, lawn furniture, totes, yogurt cups, microwave trays, plant pots, plant trays and inserts, coolers, shelving, garbage cans and 5-gallon water bottles. All metal must be removed from plastic. **NO** PVC pipe/tubing, vinyl siding, plastic bags, plastic wrap, Styrofoam, water hose.

ELECTRONICS: Includes computers and all accessories, hard drives, monitors, laptops, televisions, VCR/DVD players, phones (home and cell), fax machines, etc.

TIRES: Please remove rims if possible. Tires must be neatly stacked in the trailer provided for their disposal.

SCRAP METAL: Non-food-related scrap metal, sheet metal, lawn mowers, "white goods", bicycles, metal drums (must have a 12" hole cut in drum), etc.
